Definitely reminders that God has created a beautiful world for all of us to share and enjoy!!

P.S. Actually, it's always "God Sightings Season!!!"



Ingredients:

- 2-3 lb. of beef roast
- 1 can beef broth
- 1 envelope beefy onion soup mix
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 3-4 cloves of garlic, minced (I use garlic that comes in a jar)
- 6-8 C. beef broth/water, more if desired
- 1 pkg (24 oz) frozen noodles (we use a ½ bag dry noodles)
- Salt & Pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Combine 1 can beef broth, beefy onion soup mix, cream of mushroom soup & garlic. Stir, set aside.
- 2. Place roast in slow cooker. Add soup mixture, cover and cook on low for 8 hours.
- 3. Remove roast from slow cooker, break roast apart into bite size pieces.
- 4. Add 6 8 C. beef broth (depending on the size of the roast).
- 5. Cover & continue to cook on low for 8 hours. (Yes, you do need to start this the night before you plan on serving it.)
- 6. An hour before you eat, add the frozen noodles & cook on high. If using dry noodles, cooking on high for 30 minutes is usually enough.

Yes, this takes a long time and, yes, it makes a lot, but it is sooooo good that it's worth the wait and you'll welcome the leftovers!!
