BUCKETS

Since January we've been praying for a former Pennfield teacher and her husband. He had a double lung transplant combined with open heart surgery and she fell on the ice 2 weeks after his surgery breaking her leg in several spots that required her hip replacement to also be redone when the surgeon repaired her leg. Starting with her husband's transplant, she shared her feelings and insights on Facebook. Many of her friends thought she should put these feelings into a book – I am one of those friends. I'll share some of these in the next few months. This posting was soon after her fall and surgeries. They're both home and doing well.

People ask me why these things happen to us? What are we being led to? What is the reason? The lesson? The explanation we are supposed to somehow wrap our brains around?

You know- I don't know any of these answers and I'm honestly going to tell you- I don't believe life works that way. I don't believe we are somehow anointed to be gifted or endure something. I think we are given life to live to the best of our abilities and sometimes great things happen and sometimes

bad things happen. We make good choices. We make bad choices. We win and we lose. I think when things happen, the thing to do is learn. Change. Adjust. Rotate. Sometimes it feels unfair when bad things happen. Does it ever feel unfair when a good thing happens? I think, sometimes it does.

So, today, I'm putting things into 3 buckets. I think these buckets are going to help show direction. We have needs. We have things that we want/ 'need'/ require to fulfill us in the moment or for a short time: Bucket #1 (that amazing coffee, getting fresh hair, nails, new kicks, Diet Coke). We have things that we require to truly keep us alive and give us the life we try to live: Bucket #2 (food, sleep, water, exercise). We have Bucket #3. This bucket is our soul/ emotional bucket. Things that go here stay here. They fuel us. They give us a lift that stays for a long time. They make us feel for a while (talks with loved ones, breakfast with your kids, coffee with friends, hugs for a good day). I'm going to propose that when your bucket #1 is full, bucket #3 might not be.

I think Rob's illness, and now my injury, allow me the opportunity to reflect on these things. I think, 3 years ago, Bucket #1 was very full. Grossly full. Materials. I 'had' anything I wanted, when I wanted and never went without something that gave me that 'fix'. Shoes. Cars. Bags. Toys. Money. Eating out. Trips. I had a lot but there were days I felt very empty. Rob's illness allowed me time to think about hard things. We talked about hard things. What would life be like if Rob was gone? Where would I live? How would we face the days if we knew we had fewer than we had planned? What changes in life would we need to make? What would we make time for? How would we support one another in a very difficult journey? In those days and times, Bucket #3 became fuller and Bucket #1 fell a bit to the side and we plowed forward. The need to have items and daily favorites was so less important, much less fulfilling and certainly not life sustaining. The need to have sun on my face, a hand to hold, a hug in the morning, a time to laugh, a time to watch birds and waves and people. Time to absorb sounds. Etc. With people and soul filling things, Bucket #1 shrinks Bucket #3 expands and just like Grinch, your heart might grow 3 sizes. I'm still terrible about my phone but I try to leave it put away and live in the present as I can. I still have so far to go with this damn phone and all things social media.

So, today, I'm filling Bucket #2 with OT and PT so I can get home and work on Bucket #3. Big things ahead.

Go fill your buckets.
